### Day Two Special Sight: Iwo Jima Memorial

This memorial's proper name is the Marine Corps Memorial. Pre-trip lesson: On what famous photograph is this memorial based? On-site learning: How many battle places are mentioned more than once?

### Day Two Special Sight: Arlington National Cemetery

Home to the Tomb of the Unknowns and the graves of two U.S. Presidents. Pre-trip learning: When was “Taps” written, and by whom? On-site learning: What four wars are represented at the Tomb of the Unknowns? Which two Presidents are buried here?

### Day Two Special Site: Mount Vernon

The home of George Washington, Mount Vernon's dining room was larger than most homes of the same time period. Pre-trip learning: What happened to Washington's slaves after he died? On-site learning: How tall was Washington?

### Day Two Special Site: Air Force Memorial

Washington's newest memorial! On-site learning: What does the shape of this memorial represent?
